

Andrew Dees: Our Very First 12 Month Graduate

"I came to the Mission in January 2019. Sin had taken over my life and I had been in and out of jail constantly. The last time I was arrested, I got out and came to the Mission. It was here I began a relationship with the Lord. I have learned to put God first and everything will work out. "But seek ye first the kingdom of God and his righteousness; and

all these things shall be added unto you." Matt. 6:33. Since coming here, I have learned to work on motorcycles at Hellfighters USA and am now employed here as a mechanic. I have a band of brothers to keep me accountable. I am thankful for Mission At The Cross, Hellfighters, and most importantly God,

and I thank Him for what He has done in my life."



How Our Program Has Grown Over the Years

On December 27, 2008, Mission At The Cross opened its doors and they have been open ever since 24/7/365. At first, the Mission provided overnight lodging for those down on their luck and needing a place to stay to get back on their feet. It was not long before the need was discovered that a longer period of time was needed to effectively help men, especially since most who came through the doors were battling addiction.

The next step was to expand the program to 30 days. This expansion produced more fruit, but it was soon discovered that a thirty day program was not extensive enough to help men break chains of addiction they had worn for years and even decades. The program was then expanded to three months. Over time it was lengthened to a six month program and remained at six months for several years.

In January 2019, we began a twelve month program and have already seen fruit of the extended stay in the lives of the men. As noted on this page, Andrew Dees

was our first 12 month graduate and two more are scheduled to complete their twelve months in the next few weeks.
