

Phase IV at the Mission in Full Swing

Mission At The Cross has grown since the doors opened in December 2008. It has expanded from one building in the beginning, to several buildings including one that now houses Hellfighters USA, which supports the Mission through its profits. It has also grown in its program offerings, providing different phases of growth and accomplishment for each resident.

Phase I


Each resident is taken in and provided lodging and board in a community bunk room setting with community bathrooms, all on the first floor of the main Mission building.

Phase II


As each resident grows and develops, they can transition into a private room as they continue toward completion of the program and graduating. *The duration of Phase I & II is 12 months.*

Phase III

After graduation, each resident is offered the opportunity to transition into a private apartment on the third floor, when they have secured a job. Here they have more independence and freedom, but still attend devotions and still have their meals provided at the Mission. There is no time limit on how long each man can stay on this floor. The need varies from man to man.

Phase IV

Across the street from the main Mission building, transitional apartments are provided on the second floor of Hellfighters USA. These men also have employment and live independently with freedom to come and go, but still attend morning devotions at the Mission. There are currently four men now in Phase IV, Jody, Wendell, Joey, and Derreck.
