that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints." Ephesians 1:17,18

I am so grateful for the mercy and grace of Jesus Christ my Savior. I have been such a fool in my life, but the love of Christ for sinners like me has directed my path to Mission At The Cross. My life is now "under construction" and I am the clay on the potter's wheel, learning how not to feed an "appetite for destruction" anymore. I graduated February 10, 2020 and now work in The Armory at Hellfighters USA. Jesus is the way, the truth and the life!
